Subject: Impact of Revisions to Daylight-saving Time

Upcoming changes to the daylight-saving time schedule may have an impact on Multi-Net<sup>®</sup> infrastructure time stamping. This bulletin clarifies those impacts.

Historically, daylight-saving time began on the last Sunday in March and ended on the last Sunday in October. Starting in 2007, daylight-saving time will begin on the second Sunday in March and end on the first Sunday in November. The computers in your Multi-Net<sup>®</sup> system will not automatically adjust to this revised schedule, meaning that time stamping will be incorrect.

Any computer that is using the Windows XP operating software with Service Pack 2, can obtain a patch from Microsoft's website to facilitate the revised daylight-saving time schedule.

All other computer operating systems will not accommodate the revised schedule, and must be adjusted manually. Owners of these PCs should go into the control panel and unclick the setting that tells the machine to automatically change the clock for daylight-saving time. You will then have to change the time manually at the beginning and end of daylight-saving time each year.
